Dear Patient,

You are receiving this letter because you've purchased tirzepatide from our pharmacy.

We wanted to make you aware that the FDA has removed tirzepatide from their "drug shortage list."

What does this mean?

Due to this action, pharmacies are no longer able to offer the **compounded version** of tirzepatide.

As of **March 17th** we will no longer be able to dispense the compounded version of tirzepatide.

Our pharmacists are available to discuss alternative solutions to meet your needs.

Options to consider:

- Purchase 3 to 4 months supply of tirzepatide prior to March 17th to provide you
 more time to get a plan. We will need to know by March 5th for ordering purposes
 if you'd like to do this.
- Switch to the branded product, Zepbound, if available and affordable.
- Semaglutide is an alternative compounded GLP product that we are still able to offer since it's still on the FDA shortage list.
